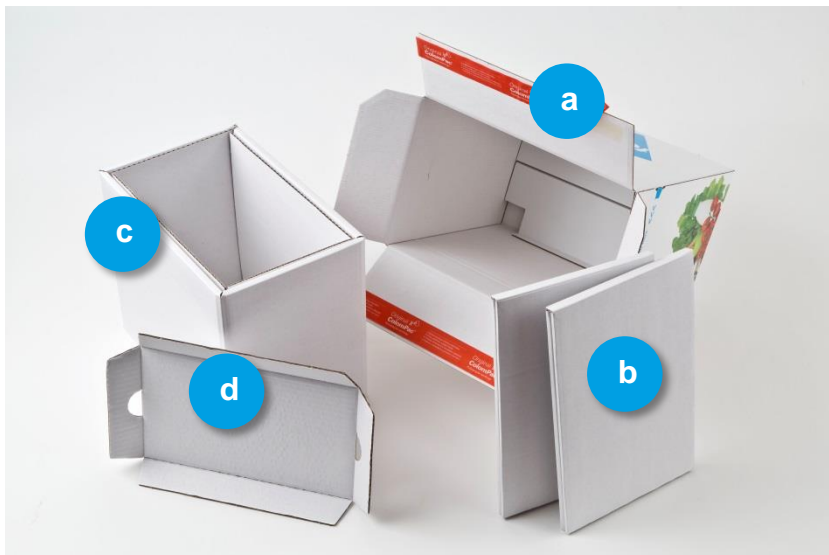


foodmailer® ready to ship set-up



1. Outer box (see fig. a): the bottom pieces should fit flush to each other before you attach the lower outer flaps.
2. Place one of the two covers (see fig. b) on the bottom.
3. Fold the insulating ring (see fig. c) and install to perfectly fit.
4. Place half of the IcePackEco amount (printed side up) prescribed by the foodmailer® calculator.
5. Place the merchandise, with as little space between the pieces as possible. Large gaps between the pieces reduce the cooling period (if needed, add one more IcePackEco unit).
6. Place the remainder of the IcePackEco units on top with the printed side down.
7. Place the intermediate insert (see fig. d) when necessary. Fill the remaining space with filling material (crepe paper, etc.) or add merchandise which does not need cooling to make the cooled space as compact as possible.
8. Place the second cover (see fig. b) on top.
9. All the inner elements should fit flush.
10. The outer box may not be cooled before closure; otherwise, optimal adhesive bonding cannot be guaranteed.
